SCOPE OF WORK:

Crocker Ltd stabilized the north wall, which included stone and adobe repair, repointing with mud and lime mortars, and structural splicing of vigas. A final exterior plaster was designed using different colored renders to highlight the building's historic sequence of repairs and remodels.
